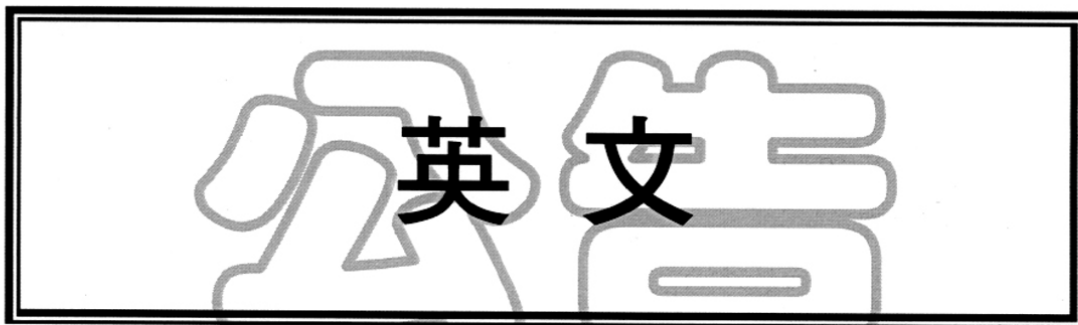

A blog can be considered as a journal that can continuously allow the users to update their own words and post their work online through software. Its simple interface is so easy to perform, demanding no professional knowledge of web scripting. Thus, anyone who can create a basic word document can create and maintain a blog. In addition, one can even add pictures or audio files to improve a blog's attractiveness. What's more, a blog is interactive in the sense that readers can respond with comments in just a few steps. Online forums can also take place on any blog site.

Most blogs on the Internet are personal or journalistic. However, there have been an increasing number of people using blogs in education. In terms of teaching and learning, students could use a personal blog to document and demonstrate **their** development over time. Hence, blogs could be used to **monitor** and assess students' work as well as encourage interactions between students and teachers.

Blogs can be used in many different ways. One of them is to provide tools for reading in a language other than one's mother tongue, through the interactive nature of blogs. One can read and also comment on what one reads with the expectation of a little discussion and a quest for common interests and individual differences. By writing on blogs, people can get feedback from other audiences all over cyberspace. Students have an opportunity to read things they are interested in and write things they truly wish to write, thereby combining their texts with conversations in a very personal and stimulating way. In other words, blogs allow people to exchange information without space and time constraints to broaden their knowledge and meet personal needs and interests at the same time.

Dear Language Center Director,

I have just returned from the summer language program at your center for English and I am writing to express my strong dissatisfaction.

To begin with, the center was not at all as I had expected from your advertisement. The courses for junior students were not properly managed; therefore, the students were running around in a wild, noisy, and distracting manner during class time.

Secondly, the “highly qualified teachers” turned out to be university students taking on summer jobs as instructors. With limited formal educational training, they had little knowledge of English composition. Their teaching techniques were not wide-ranged, but dull and monotonous.
